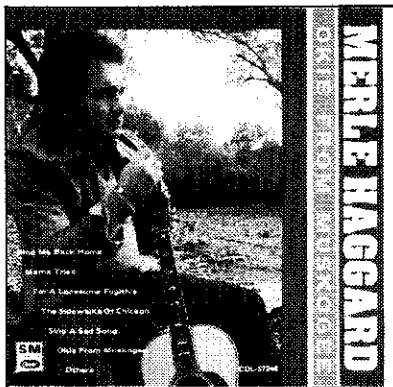
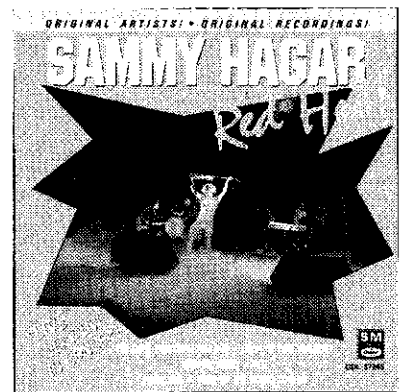
CDL-57244 GRAND FUNK RAILROAD • HEAVY HITTERS!

Since the start of his long, happily continuing career, Merle's stood tall in insisting his music remain true to the fundamental truth-saying values and authenticity of feeling that always have characterized country music at its best and most fulfilling. And in his songwriting and performing, his whole understanding of and approach to music, Merle has acknowledged country music's deep, nourishing roots in everyday life and the traditional values that make us what we are. He's never strayed from them and because of this his songs—*Okie From Muskogee*, *Sing Me Back Home*, *Mama Tried*, *Today I Started Loving You Again* are good examples—have touched us where we live. In his direct, unpretentious music, bearing country's highest standards, Merle not only tells the truth but tells it with riveting artistry. Country music can do no more than this.
